The portfolio aimed to fund smaller-scale permanent projects (valued at \$100,000 or more) to make a positive difference primarily to local communities for 20-50 years and leave a legacy to the Appeal. Priority was given to small to medium scale, multi-purpose, collaborative projects that directly met an earthquake-related need and invested in the future of Canterbury.
